

ACT PUBLIC HOLIDAYS 2025

The following public holidays will be observed in the Australian Capital Territory during 2025.

| Canberra Day | Monday 10 March 2025 |
| Good Friday | Friday 18 April 2025 |

| Easter Sunday | Sunday 20 April 2025 |
| Easter Monday | Monday 21 April 2025 |
| ANZAC Day | Friday 25 April 2025 |
| Reconciliation Day | Monday 2 June 2025** |
| King's Birthday | Monday 9 June 2025 |
| Labour Day | Monday 6 October 2025 |
| Christmas Day | Thursday 25 December 2025 |
| Boxing Day | Friday 26 December 2025 |

Note: All public holiday dates are accurate at the time of publication. Information is sourced from the *Holidays Act 1958* (ACT).

*As 26 January (Australia Day) falls on a Sunday in 2025, the public holiday is observed on the following Monday.

** As 27 May (Reconciliation Day) does not fall on a Monday in 2025, the public holiday is observed on the following Monday.

The *Holidays Act 1958* also provides for bank holidays in the ACT. In addition to the above public holidays, there is a bank holiday on the first Monday in August. Bank holidays do not apply to everyone. Employers and employees are advised to check the *Holidays Act 1958* for all bank holidays and refer to their relevant Enterprise Agreement or Award.
